The Portuguese Road Safety Association (PRP) and the European Transport Safety Council (ETSC) are delighted to invite you to the YEARS national event in Lisbon to debate on the dangers and policy recommendations for young road users in the European Union.

YEARS (Young Europeans Acting for Road Safety) is a three year project jointly managed by the ETSC and the Parliamentary Advisory Council on Transport Safety (PACTS from UK) and funded by the European Commission, The German Road Safety Council and VIAS Belgium.

The project seeks to offer a better understanding of young drivers as a road users group particularly at risk and address this risk through innovative actions.

YEARS looks at the current situation in EU Member States and the latest data on road deaths involving young people, the main risks they face and what can be done to address these, in order to raise awareness among stakeholders and spur on national administrations to take action and reduce the number of young people killed on the roads.

In addition, the project has mobilized students from leading European Universities to run road safety projects for vulnerable users in their community. The three best projects will be awarded at the final YEARS event in September in Brussels. In the framework of the YEARS project, ETSC has been cooperating with the Technical University of Lisbon, from which two students have developed a road safety project to improve pedestrians' safety in the city with successful achievements.

The event will be the occasion to learn about good practices and effective measures adopted across Europe which will be presented by Road Safety experts from different EU countries.

This conference welcomes road safety professionals and those interested in the field of road safety, health and youth protection.
